7:15-8pm "CPC 101" Presentation – Seattle Community Police Commission

Seattle's Police Department has undergone major reforms in recent years, stemming from issues with use of force and biased policing. The Community Police Commission (CPC) was formed in 2013 as part of the settlement agreement for police reforms mandated by the federal government (the "consent decree"). CPC provides ongoing, community-based oversight of SPD and the police accountability system. Under 2017 city legislation, the CPC was made permanent and its scope and staffing broadened.

Jesse Franz, CPC Communication Advisor, and Nick Christian, Community Engagement Specialist, will present a "CPC 101" overview, describing the history of the organization and newly expanded scope, followed by a community Q&A.
